Claims Against Family Broadcasting Corporation (formerly LeSEA) Dismissed

(Thursday, December 13, 2018) In an order issued on December 12, 2018, the Saint Joseph Superior Court granted summary judgment against Lester Leonard Sumrall and the Estate of James H. Murphy on all claims that they had asserted against the corporate entities of LeSEA (including Family Broadcasting Corporation).

As a result of the court's order, these LeSEA corporate entities are no longer parties to the trial court proceedings, which have been pending since May 2016. This favorable ruling for the LeSEA corporate entities follows the dismissal of similar Counterclaims brought by Lester Leonard Sumrall against these LeSEA entities in 2016, as well as additional rulings in LeSEA's favor, including, but not limited to, an order denying a motion for a temporary restraining order filed by Lester Leonard Sumrall in January 2018, and multiple failed attempts by Lester Leonard Sumrall to open an estate for LeSEA's founder, Dr. Lester Sumrall, 20 years after his passing.

Today's ruling confirms that the allegations brought by Lester Leonard Sumrall against LeSEA have no basis in law or fact. Although not addressed in the order, LeSEA wishes to clarify that it was never the subject of any State or Federal investigations, as Lester Leonard Sumrall has falsely stated publicly.
